

Introduction to ClubV1 Members Hub

ClubV1 Members Hub is an app that gives registered members of Middleton Hall Golf Club access to member information including –

- **Members Directory.** This displays a list of members together with their handicap. Members are responsible for their own privacy by allowing or withholding mobile phone numbers and email addresses. This facility will replace the Members Directory which has been removed from the club's current website.
- **Competition Results**. The results of past and current competitions may be accessed. A live leader board of competitions in progress is also a feature.
- **Documents.** General information is published here under Ladies, Gents, Seniors, Junior and All Members sections. Documents included are competition rules, minutes of meeting, fixtures etc. This list is not exhaustive and may be added to from time to time by the club.
- Handicap Certificates. Members may access and print handicap certificates from any device that the app is installed on.
- Latest News. The club will publish and maintain any news relevant to members.

The foregoing are currently available features that may be added to in the future.

Download the app.

To use the app, you must login using your existing HowDidiDo details, or register for an account if you haven't used HowDidiDo before. To verify that you are a registered member of Middleton Hall Golf Club, you will be prompted to verify your membership information. The email address you log in with must match that which the club has on record for you. On 1st launch you will be asked to select your club. You will also be asked to verify the 1st line of your address that is on record at club.

Important. Once the app is functional you should select Account/Privacy and tick the contact details that you are prepared to share with other MHGC registered members. The options available are email address and mobile number. If you prefer to use your land line number as a means of contact, you will need to edit your profile. To do this select Account/Profile and insert your land line number in the Mobile box then click or tap the Submit Update button.
